COMPLAINTS

The Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council investigates and prosecutes professional misconduct committed by marriage and family therapists, professional counselors, psychologists, psychological associates, social workers, and licensed specialists in school psychology.

Although not every complaint against or dispute with a license involves professional misconduct, the Executive Council will provide you with information about how to file a complaint: An individual who wishes to file a complaint against a Licensed Professional Counselor or Licensed Social Worker may write to:
